

Directions from Chatham-Kent: Take ON-401 E from ON-40 S. Turn left to merge onto ON-401 E toward London. Keep right at the fork to continue on ON-403 E, follow signs for Brantford/Hamilton/ Niagara Falls. Take the exit toward Ontario 8/Main St. E. Merge onto Main St. W/Hamilton Regional Rd 8. Turn left onto Macnab Street, then left again on King St. W. The destination will be on your right.

From Niagara Falls: Head North on Stanley Ave/Regional Rd 102 toward Spring Street. Turn left onto ON-420 W and then merge onto Queen Elizabeth Way.
